BACKGROUND

The implementation of Traffic Management at Work Zones based on JKR Arahan Teknik Jalan (ATJ) and Standard Road Specification (SPJ) has been enforced since 26 Disember 2017 through Surat Arahan Ketua Pengarah Kerja Raya. Additionally, the ATJ and SPJ was officially launched on the 6 March 2018 by the Deputy Minister of Works. Thus, it's been a year since the last seminar and the outcome from these guidelines are yet to be determined.

OVERVIEW

Construction, maintenance works and any enabling works on the road or within the roadway, in the absence of adequate planning, organization and implementation may lead to unsafe conditions for workers, and all road users. Therefore, a proper and comprehensive Traffic Management at Work Zones is of vital importance to ascertain that the systems are in place for the works to proceed safely, for the benefit of road users and workers.

AIM

To discuss challenges and cutting-edge solutions to help improve the safe and efficient movement of traffic under many different roadway conditions.

OBJECTIVE

To promote JKR's Arahan Teknik Jalan (ATJ) and Standard Road Specification (SPJ) concerning Traffic Management at Work Zone.

Included in the booth rental package is a complete shell-scheme system (details as shown in the plan) consisting of the following fixtures and fittings:

- Booth Size : 3 m x 3 m x 2.5 m height – refer to layout floor plan.
- Walls : Shell-scheme structure of three sides white laminated dividing partitions (two laminated panels for corner/end lots and where specified in the layout plan).
- Fascia : One fascia board at the front, and side if applicable, with Exhibitor's name and booth number in standard cut-out block lettering.
- Floor : 3 m x 3 m Carpet underlay for flooring within exhibit booth where applicable.
- Lighting : Two 40W fluorescent lights.
- Power Point : One unit of 13 amp/230V power socket.
- Loose Furniture : One information table (100cm x 50cm x 76cm), two folding chairs and one waste paper basket.

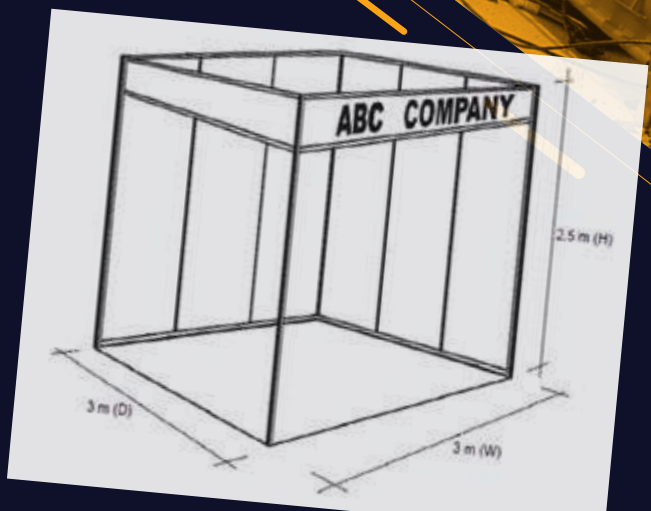

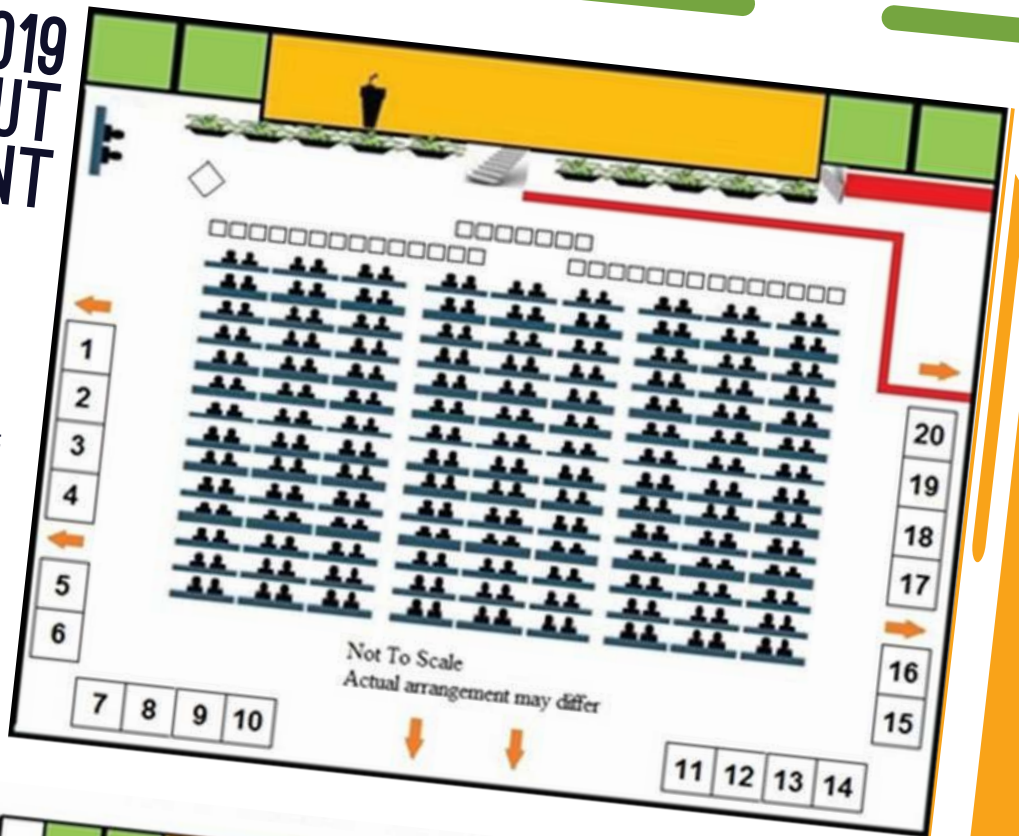

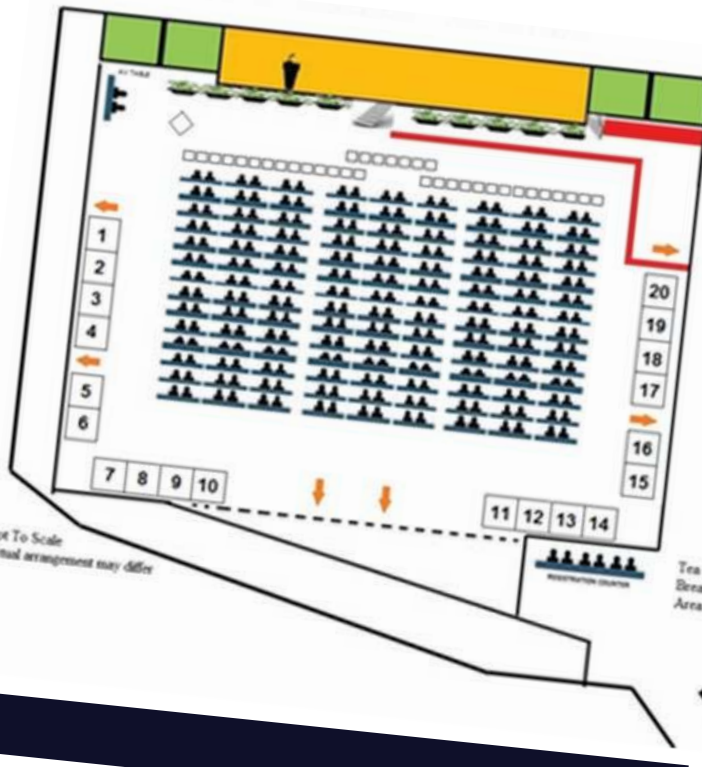
